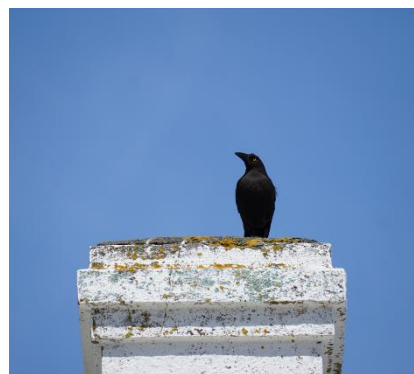


Off Island: Everyone's an Artist

GUIDELINES

This exhibition has community at the heart. Please consider these guidelines below before completing the application form below:

- One or two submissions per person only
- Each submission needs to have some connection to the events theme of Islands and/or Birds. As it is your piece, you may determine how the theme exists within your work.
- All mediums are welcomed. Sculpture, canvas, wood, poetry, movement, creative writing, textiles, music ...
- There is no age limit
- The space at the Geilston Bay Boat Club is basic. Each artwork will create the magic. We kindly request your artwork be able to fit on a trestle table or be free standing / propped up as you require.
- You are responsible for how it is displayed (e.g. bring an easel, blocks to prop it up on the table). There is one free standing pin board which can be utilised. This will serve 2 artists.
- We understand tables are not ideal for hanging objects. It's the reality of the space, so reach out and we'll put our thinking caps on to find a way for your piece to shine brightly, despite space restrictions. Let's get resourceful together.
- You, as the exhibiting artist, are responsible for set up and pack down of your artwork.
- Set up time is 8am – 9:30am on the event day, 16th August. The art will stay on display until 3:30pm, when you can collect.
- We will do our best to take exceptional care with your artwork on the day. At the same time, by entering this exhibition, you acknowledge and accept full responsibility for your artwork while on display and part of the event.

AWARDS + PRIZES

There are 4 Award categories judged on the day: People's Choice Award; First Time Exhibitor Award; Judges Choice Award; and Young Artist Award.

We have some prizes for these awards which will be announced closer to the date.
